

Rosa's Market Adventure: Spanish Numbers (0-100)

Learning objective: To accurately use and spell Spanish numbers from 0 to 100 to calculate totals and manage a market stall budget.

Read Rosa the Parrot's market report below. Use your knowledge of Spanish numbers to solve the mathematical problems and translate the prices correctly.

Rosa the parrot is helping at the village market. She has a list of items and their prices in Spanish. A basket of apples costs 'treinta y cinco' pence. A loaf of fresh bread costs 'cuarenta y dos' pence. Rosa wants to buy one of each for her friends. She also sees a special jar of honey that costs 'ochenta y ocho' pence. She needs to calculate her total spending carefully to ensure she stays within her budget of £1.50.

Word bank: cero (0) · diez (10) · veinte (20) · treinta (30) · cuarenta (40) · cincuenta (50) · sesenta (60) · setenta (70) · ochenta (80) · noventa (90) · cien (100) · más (plus) · cuesta (costs)

1. Translate the following prices into digits: 'treinta y cinco' pence and 'cuarenta y dos' pence. (2 marks)

2. Calculate the total cost of the apples and the bread in pence. Write your answer in Spanish words. (2 marks)

3. If Rosa has £1.00 (cien peniques), does she have enough money to buy the jar of honey which costs 'ochenta y ocho' pence? Explain your reasoning. (3 marks)

4. Compare and contrast the structure of Spanish numbers between 20 and 30 with numbers between 30 and 40. What pattern do you notice? (3 marks)

5. Justify your answer: If the honey price increased by 'diez' pence, would Rosa still be able to afford it with her original budget of £1.00? Why or why not? (3 marks)

6. What might happen if Rosa decided to buy two loaves of bread instead of one? Calculate the new total in Spanish. (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a market stall scene featuring Rosa the parrot. Label at least three items on the stall with their prices written in Spanish words (e.g., 'cincuenta peniques').



Extension challenge: Create your own 'Market Menu' featuring five items. Assign each a price in Spanish between 1 and 100. Write a short paragraph explaining a shopping scenario where you must calculate the total cost for two customers with different budgets.
