

Rosa's Spanish Opinion Party

Learning objective: To express simple opinions in Spanish using 'Me gusta' (I like) and 'No me gusta' (I do not like).

Word bank: Me gusta · No me gusta · la pizza · la manzana · el helado · el brócoli

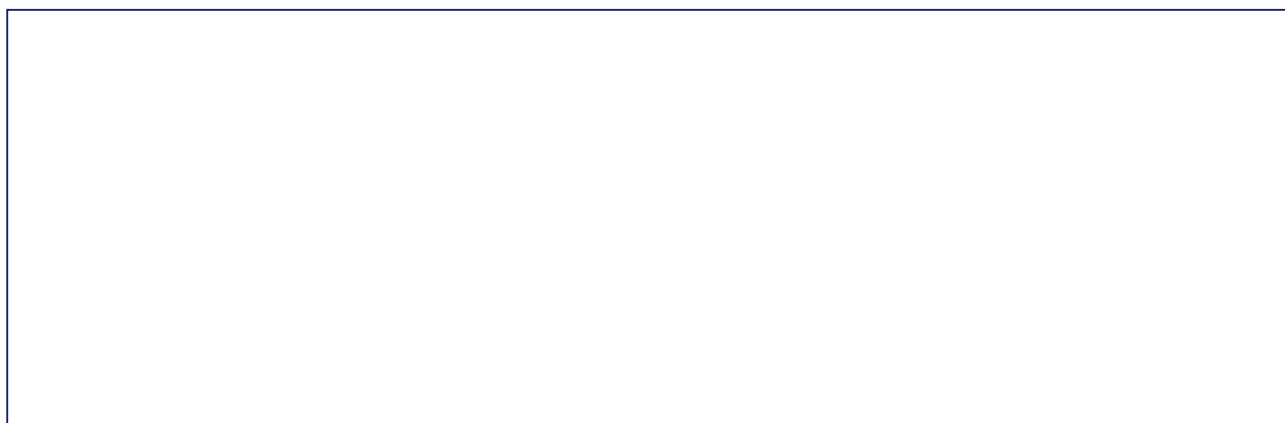
1. 1. Picture: A happy face next to a slice of pizza. (Me gusta / No me gusta) _____. (2 marks)
