

Rosa's Spanish Picnic

Learning objective: To use basic Spanish opinion phrases to describe favourite foods.

Follow the steps below to draw your favourite meal. Then, write a Spanish sentence next to your drawing to show if you like it or not.

Draw: Draw a large picnic blanket in the centre of the page. Inside the blanket, draw a meal you enjoy. Use bright colours and clear outlines. Next to the blanket, draw a smaller plate with a food item that you do not like.



Label words: Me gusta... (I like...) · No me gusta... (I do not like...) · la manzana (apple) · la pizza (pizza) · el helado (ice cream) · la ensalada (salad)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw your favourite food in the box below. Then, label your food using the Spanish word from the word bank.
2. Step 2: Use the phrase 'Me gusta...' to write a sentence about your food. Example: Me gusta la pizza.
3. Step 3: Draw a different food that you do not like. Label it with the Spanish word.
4. Step 4: Use the phrase 'No me gusta...' to write a sentence about the food you do not like.
