

¡Habla de tus gustos! (Talk about what you like!)

Join Rosa the parrot and learn how to say what you love, like, and dislike in Spanish!

- To say you like something, start your sentence with 'Me gusta'. For example, 'Me gusta el fútbol'.
- When you really love something, use 'Me encanta'. It shows you have a big passion for it!
- If you do not enjoy something, simply say 'No me gusta'.
- You can add 'mucho' to the end to make your opinion stronger, like 'Me gusta mucho el chocolate'.
- To agree with a friend, you can say 'A mí también', which means 'Me too'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, when you want to say you like something plural, like 'I like apples', you change the phrase slightly to 'Me gustan las manzanas'. Rosa the parrot always remembers to check if the word is singular or plural!
