Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish phrases to express likes and dislikes.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. Today we are going to talk about what we like. Use the phrases in the word bank to tell me about your favourite things. Start your sentences with the phrases provided.

Word bank: Me gusta... (I like...) · No me gusta... (I do not like...) · el fútbol (football) · la pizza (pizza) · leer (reading) · el chocolate (chocolate) · pintar (painting)

1. Write one thing you like. Start with 'Me gusta...' (2 marks)

2. Write one thing you do not like. Start with 'No me gusta...' (2 marks)

3. Look at the word bank. Write a full sentence about a food you like. (2 marks)

4. Write a sentence about an activity (like reading or painting) that you like. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend what they like in Spanish? Try saying: '¿Qué te gusta?'
