

Rosa's Spanish Opinion Workshop

Learning objective: To learn how to express opinions in Spanish using simple phrases.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. Today we are going to learn how to say what we like in Spanish. Use the word bank to help you complete the sentences. Look at the symbols to help you decide which phrase to use.

Word bank: Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like) · el fútbol (football) · la pizza (pizza) · el helado (ice cream) · la escuela (school)

1. Look at the symbol (■). Write the Spanish phrase for 'I like' and add 'the pizza'. (2 marks)
2. Look at the symbol (■■). Write the Spanish phrase for 'I do not like' and add 'the football'. (2 marks)
3. Complete the sentence: 'Me gusta _____' (Choose your favourite food from the word bank). (2 marks)
4. Complete the sentence: 'No me gusta _____' (Choose something you do not like from the word bank). (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite food in the box below and write the sentence 'Me gusta...' next to it.



Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend what they like in Spanish? Try saying: '¿Te gusta...?' (Do you like...?) followed by the word for an object.
