

Spanish Assessment: Mi Vida Escolar (My School Life)

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of school subjects, opinions, and daily routines in Spanish.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in Spanish where appropriate. Ensure your spellings are accurate and use the word bank provided for guidance.

Rosa the parrot is telling her friends about her school day. She says: 'Hola. En mi escuela, estudio muchas asignaturas. Mi asignatura favorita es la geografía porque me gusta aprender sobre el mundo. Las matemáticas son difíciles, pero interesantes. No me gusta la educación física porque es muy cansada. El arte es mi momento creativo del día.'

Word bank: las matemáticas (maths) · la historia (history) · el arte (art) · la educación física (PE) · la geografía (geography) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like) · es aburrido (it is boring) · es interesante (it is interesting) · difícil (difficult) · fácil (easy) · mi asignatura favorita (my favourite subject)

1. Based on the passage, identify Rosa's favourite subject and explain why she likes it. (2 marks)

2. Why does Rosa find mathematics challenging yet engaging? Answer in English. (2 marks)

3. Translate the following sentences into Spanish: 'I like Art' and 'PE is boring'. (2 marks)

4. If you were to describe your own school timetable, which three subjects would you choose to write about? State the subject in Spanish and provide one opinion for each using the vocabulary provided. (6 marks)

5. Compare and contrast Rosa's feelings about Geography and PE. Justify your answer using evidence from the text. (4 marks)

6. Creative Writing Task: Write a short paragraph (4-5 sentences) in Spanish describing your ideal school day. Include what subjects you study, what you think of them, and what time you finish school (e.g., Termino a las tres). (9 marks)

Draw: Draw a scene of a classroom where students are participating in their favourite subject. Label three items in the classroom using Spanish vocabulary (e.g., la mesa, el libro, el profesor).



Extension challenge: Imagine a new subject has been added to the curriculum. Write a persuasive argument in Spanish explaining why this subject is important, using connectives such as 'porque' (because) and 'y' (and). Total: /25
