

Mi Vida Escolar: Rosa's School Diary

Learning objective: To write a descriptive diary entry in Spanish about school life, using subject vocabulary and adjectives to express opinions.

Imagine you are spending a day at school with Rosa the parrot. Use the vocabulary provided to complete the diary entry below. Describe your favourite subjects, what you eat for lunch, and why you enjoy your school day. Use the 'Greater Depth' questions to justify your opinions and compare your school experience to others.

1. Introducción: Describe your school day using the date and a greeting. How do you feel about arriving at school today? (2 marks)

2. Las Asignaturas: List two subjects you have today. Explain why you find these subjects interesting or challenging using adjectives. (4 marks)

3. El Almuerzo: Describe what you eat at lunchtime. Is your school canteen food healthy? Justify your opinion. (3 marks)

4. Comparación: Compare your morning lessons with your afternoon lessons. Which part of the day is more productive and why? (4 marks)

5. Análisis: If you could change one thing about your school timetable to make it more 'divertido' (fun), what would it be and why? (4 marks)

6. Reflexión: Explain why learning a language like Spanish is important for someone who wants to travel the world, like Rosa the parrot. (5 marks)

Extension challenge: Creative Writing Task: Write a short paragraph in Spanish imagining a 'dream school' subject. Describe what you would learn, what equipment you would need, and why it would be the most important lesson of the week.
