

Rosa's Spanish Market Adventure: Shopping Template

Learning objective: To use accurate Spanish vocabulary and currency notation (£) to construct a dialogue and calculate costs in a shopping scenario.

Imagine you are visiting a bustling market with Rosa. Your task is to complete this shopping record. Use your Spanish vocabulary to describe the items, their prices in pounds, and the interaction between the customer and the shopkeeper. Ensure you use the correct currency symbols and show your working out for any calculations.

1. The Shopping List: List three items you wish to purchase at the market. Write the item name in Spanish and assign a price in pounds (£) to each. (3 marks)

2. The Transaction: Write a short Spanish dialogue between you and the shopkeeper. Include asking for the price and saying thank you. (4 marks)

3. Maths Challenge: Calculate the total cost of your items. If you pay with a £20 note, how much change should you receive? Show your working out. (3 marks)

4. Explain why it is important for a shopkeeper to have a clear pricing system for customers. Justify your answer using your knowledge of maths and commerce. (4 marks)

5. Compare and contrast: How might the shopping experience differ if you were buying handmade goods from a market versus buying items from a large, automated online store? (4 marks)

6. What might happen if the shopkeeper accidentally priced an item incorrectly? Explain the steps you would take to resolve the situation politely. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Creative Task: Imagine you are designing a new product to sell at the market. Write a persuasive 'advertisement' in Spanish, including a description of the product, its price in £, and why it is the best item in the market.
