

Year 4 Spanish: Sports Assessment

Learning objective: To identify and write about sports in Spanish using the verb 'jugar' (to play) and 'hacer' (to do).

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Write clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot loves to stay active. She says: '¡Hola! I love sports. I play football with my friends, and I do swimming every Saturday.'

Word bank: fútbol (football) · baloncesto (basketball) · natación (swimming) · tenis (tennis) · juego (I play) · hago (I do) · me gusta (I like)

1. Rosa says she plays football. Look at the word bank. Write the Spanish word for football. (2 marks)

3. Match the sport to the action. Write 'juego' (I play) or 'hago' (I do) next to these sports:

5. Write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) about the sports you do. Use 'juego' or 'hago' and say if you like them. Example: Me gusta el fútbol. Yo juego al fútbol. (8 marks)

6. Why is it good for your body to do sports? Write one reason. (5 marks)
