

Rosa's Sports Fact-File

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary for sports and express likes and dislikes.

Hola! I am Rosa. Today we are learning how to talk about sports in Spanish. Use the word bank to help you fill in your fact-file. Remember to use 'Me gusta' if you like the sport, or 'No me gusta' if you do not.

Word bank: El fútbol (football) · El tenis (tennis) · La natación (swimming) · El baloncesto (basketball) · Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like)

1. My favourite sport is: (Write the name of the sport in Spanish) (2 marks)

2. Do you like this sport? (Start your sentence with 'Me gusta' or 'No me gusta') (2 marks)

3. Why do you like this sport? (You can use simple words like 'es divertido' meaning 'it is fun') (2 marks)

4. Name one other sport you know in Spanish: (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to write one full sentence in Spanish about a sport you play with your friends.
