Learning objective: To learn and apply Spanish vocabulary related to sports and physical activities, and to express preferences using 'me gusta' and 'no me gusta'.

6. What might happen if you only ever played one type of sport? Discuss the benefits of variety for developing different physical skills. (3 marks)
