

Year 5 Spanish Assessment: Los Deportes (Sports)

Learning objective: To demonstrate knowledge of Spanish sports vocabulary, verb conjugation (jugar/hacer), and the ability to express opinions about physical activities.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in Spanish where required. Ensure you use correct accents and spelling. Rosa the Parrot is cheering for you!

Rosa the Parrot is visiting a sports centre. She sees many children playing. She notes: 'En el centro deportivo, los niños juegan al fútbol en el campo. Algunos nadan en la piscina, y otros hacen atletismo en la pista. ¡Es un lugar muy activo!'

Word bank: el fútbol (football) · el baloncesto (basketball) · la natación (swimming) · el tenis (tennis) · el atletismo (athletics) · jugar (to play) · hacer (to do) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I don't like) · porque (because) · divertido (fun) · difícil (difficult)

1. Using the passage, identify two sports mentioned and translate them into English. (2 marks)

2. Conjugate the verb 'jugar' (to play) for the following: 'Yo...' (I play) and 'Ellos...' (They play). (2 marks)

3. Explain why we use 'jugar al' for football but 'hacer' for athletics. What is the grammatical rule? (3 marks)

4. Write three full sentences in Spanish describing sports you like or dislike, including a reason for each (e.g., 'porque es divertido'). (3 marks)

5. Compare and contrast team sports and individual sports. Why might someone prefer one over the other? Justify your answer in English. (4 marks)

6. Imagine you are explaining the rules of a new sport to a Spanish-speaking friend. Write a short paragraph (50-60 words) in Spanish describing the sport, the equipment needed, and why you enjoy it. (5 marks)

7. If you were to open a sports shop, list three items you would sell and their prices in pounds (£). Use Spanish for the items. (6 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite sport being played in a Spanish-speaking country. Label the equipment using Spanish vocabulary.
