

¡A Jugar! (Let's Play!): Sports in Spanish

- To say 'I play football', we use the phrase 'Juego al fútbol'.
- For individual sports like swimming, we say 'Hago natación'.
- The word 'equipo' is used to describe the group of people you play with.
- When asking someone what they play, you ask '¿Qué juegas?'.
- Adding 'mucho' (a lot) after the activity shows how much you enjoy it, such as 'Hago mucha gimnasia'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, we use two different verbs for sports! We use 'jugar' for ball games like football or tennis, but we use 'hacer' for activities like swimming or gymnastics. It is a brilliant way to categorise our exercise!

Key vocabulary: jugar al fútbol (to play football) · jugar al tenis (to play tennis) · hacer natación (to do swimming) · hacer gimnasia (to do gymnastics) · el equipo (the team) · el partido (the match) · la pelota (the ball) · ¡Qué divertido! (How fun!)
