

Rosa the Parrot's Transport Assessment

Learning objective: To identify and write Spanish vocabulary for different types of transport.

Hello! I am Rosa. I love to fly! Use the word bank to help you answer these questions. Write your answers in Spanish.

Rosa the parrot travels all over the world. She sees many ways to travel. Look at the pictures below and name them in Spanish.

Word bank: el coche (car) · el autobús (bus) · el tren (train) · la bicicleta (bicycle) · el avión (plane) · el barco (boat)

1. Rosa sees a red vehicle on the road with four wheels. It is a car. Write the Spanish word for 'car'. (2 marks)

2. Many people sit on this large vehicle to go to school. It is a bus. Write the Spanish word for 'bus'. (2 marks)

3. Rosa flies high in the sky next to a large flying machine. It is a plane. Write the Spanish word for 'plane'. (2 marks)

4. Finn the dolphin sees a vehicle floating on the sea. It is a boat. Write the Spanish word for 'boat'. (2 marks)

5. Max the monkey wants to go fast on two wheels. He rides a bicycle. Write the Spanish word for 'bicycle'. (2 marks)

6. You want to go to the seaside. Which transport would you choose? Write a sentence in Spanish: 'I go by...' (Voy en...) (5 marks)

7. Rosa asks: Why do we use different transport? Write one reason in English. (5 marks)

8. Max has £5.00. A bus ticket costs £2.00. How much money does he have left? Show your working. (5 marks)
