Learning objective: To read and understand a short text about transport in Spanish and answer questions based on the content.

Read the text carefully. Use the word bank to help you understand the Spanish words. Write your answers in the boxes provided.

¡Hola! My name is Rosa. I love to travel to different places. Today, I am looking at how we move around. In the city, I see el autobús. It is big and yellow. It is good for short trips. Sometimes, the bus is a bit slow. Next, I see el tren. It travels on long tracks. It is very fast and takes many people to the coast. Finally, I look at the sky. I see el avión. It flies high above the clouds. It is the fastest way to travel to a new country. I like to travel by train because I can see the beautiful trees from the window. Which way do you like to travel?

1. What colour is the bus that Rosa sees in the city? (2 marks)

2. Which transport does Rosa say is the fastest way to travel to a new country? (2 marks)

3. Why might Rosa prefer the train instead of the bus? (2 marks)

4. How do you know that Rosa enjoys looking at nature while she travels? (2 marks)

5. Which form of transport is your favourite? Explain why. (2 marks)
