

Spanish Verbs and Tenses Assessment: Rosa the Parrot's Language Lab

Learning objective: To recognise and use high-frequency Spanish verbs in the present tense.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the Spanish words. Write your answers on the lines provided. You can do this, you clever explorers!

Rosa the parrot loves to talk. She says: 'Hola! I am Rosa. I speak Spanish every day. I eat fruit, I live in a tree, and I dance in the sun.'

Word bank: hablo (I speak) · como (I eat) · vivo (I live) · bailo (I dance) · canto (I sing) · yo (I) · tú (you) · es (is)

2. Rosa likes to eat. How do you say 'I eat' in Spanish? (2 marks)

4. Rosa loves music. Circle the correct word to finish the sentence: 'Yo _____' (I sing). (2 marks)

5. Match the Spanish word to the English meaning by drawing a line or writing the pair. (4 marks)

6. Rosa wants to know about you! Write three short sentences about yourself using the words from the bank. Start each sentence with 'Yo' (I). (8 marks)

7. 7. Why is it helpful to learn a new language? Write one short sentence. (5 marks)
