

Rosa's Action Adventure: Spanish Verbs

Learning objective: To use and identify simple Spanish verbs in the present tense through drawing and labelling.

Follow the steps below to draw a scene for each Spanish verb. Use your word bank to label your pictures correctly. You can use the sentence starters provided to describe what is happening.

Draw: Divide your page into four equal squares. In each square, draw a simple scene showing a character performing an action (eating, playing, reading, or sleeping). Use a clean, cartoon style with bold outlines. Ensure each drawing clearly shows the action described in the word bank.



Label words: comer (to eat) · jugar (to play) · leer (to read) · dormir (to sleep) · la fruta (the fruit) · el libro (the book) · el balón (the ball)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a picture of a character eating. Label it 'comer'. Sentence starter: Yo como...
2. Step 2: Draw a picture of a character playing with a ball. Label it 'jugar'. Sentence starter: Yo juego...
3. Step 3: Draw a picture of a character reading a book. Label it 'leer'. Sentence starter: Yo leo...
4. Step 4: Draw a picture of a character sleeping. Label it 'dormir'. Sentence starter: Yo duermo...
