

Rosa's Spanish Verb Adventure!

Jump into Spanish! Learn how to talk about what you do, what you did, and what you will do!

- The 'Presente' tells us what is happening right now, like 'Yo como' (I eat).
- The 'Pasado' tells us what already finished, like 'Yo comí' (I ate).
- The 'Futuro' tells us what will happen later, like 'Yo comeré' (I will eat).
- Verbs are action words that describe movement, thinking, or doing.
- In Spanish, most verbs end in -ar, -er, or -ir when they are in their base form.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, the end of the verb changes to tell us who is doing the action! If you change the end of the word 'hablar' (to speak), you can tell people who is speaking without even using the word for 'I', 'you', or 'we'. It is like a secret code!
