

Spanish Verbs with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To learn how to use common Spanish verbs and understand how they change.

Rosa the Parrot loves to speak Spanish! Use the word bank to help you complete the sentences. Look at the English clues to help you choose the right word.

Word bank: hablar · comer · vivir · bebo · canto

1. Rosa wants to say 'to speak' in Spanish. Which word from the bank should she use? (1 mark)

2. Rosa is eating a snack. The word for 'to eat' is 'comer'. If she says 'Yo ____ una manzana' (I eat an apple), which word fits? (1 mark)

3. Complete the sentence: 'Yo ____ agua' (I drink water). Choose the word that means 'drink'. (1 mark)

4. Rosa loves music. Write the Spanish word for 'I sing' from the word bank. (1 mark)

5. If you want to say 'to live' in Spanish, use the word 'vivir'. Write a short sentence using the word 'vivir'. (Sentence starter: Yo quiero...) (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the Parrot wearing a colourful scarf and teaching a class of birds how to speak Spanish.



Extension challenge: Can you find out how to say 'I like' in Spanish? Ask a friend or look it up to add to your vocabulary list!
