- Fall leaves can be many colors, like bright red, burnt orange, and sunny yellow.
- You can find interesting shapes and patterns on the ground, such as star-shaped maple leaves or round acorns.
- Using a crayon to rub over a leaf on paper creates a lovely texture called a 'leaf rubbing'.
- Conkers are shiny, brown seeds that fall from horse chestnut trees and are perfect for making fall art.
- When you glue different natural items together, you are making a 3D fall sculpture.
