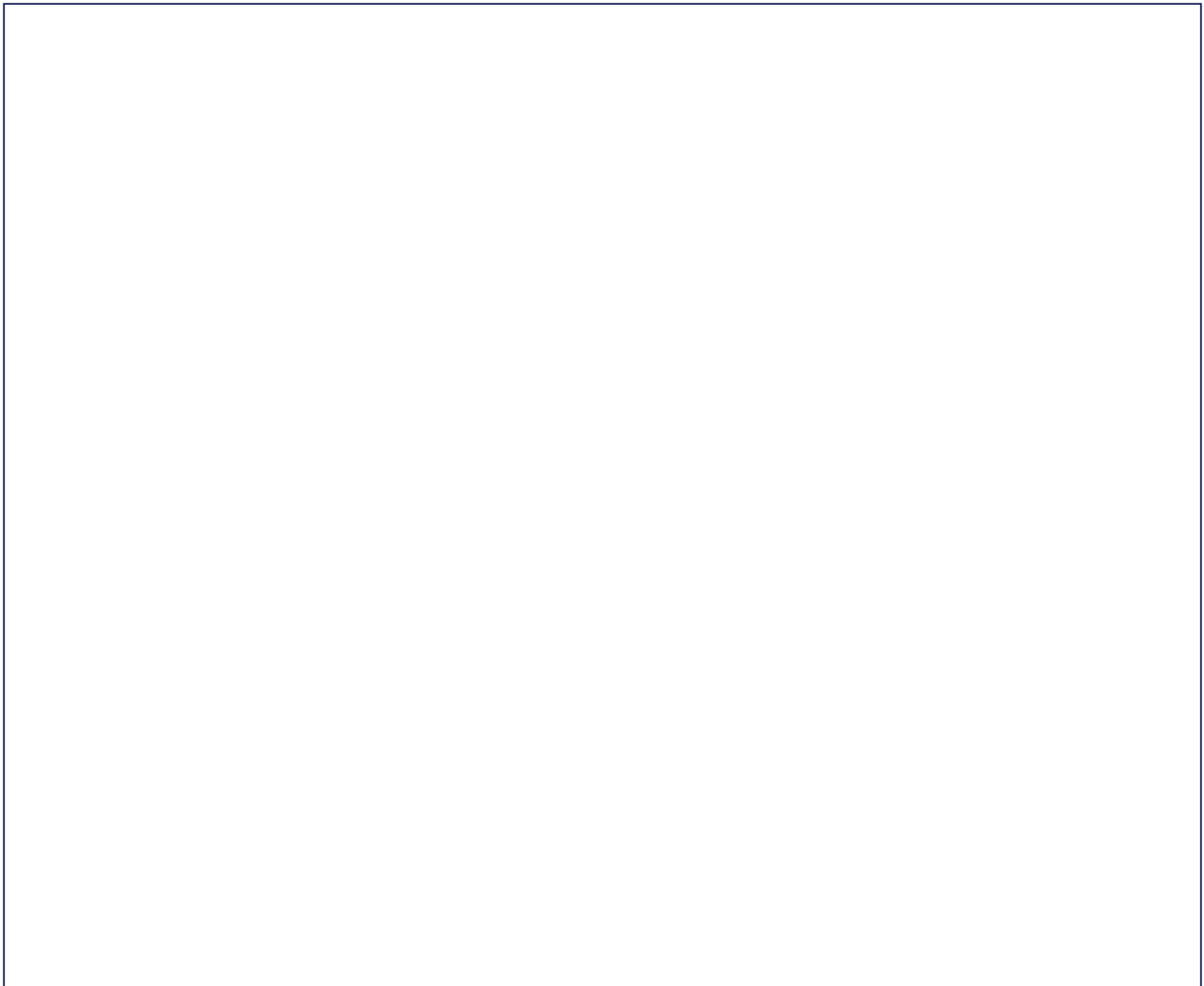


Zara's Colorful Garden

Learning objective: To understand primary and secondary colors by mixing paint or using pencils.

Follow the steps below to complete your color wheel garden. Use your coloring pencils or paints to fill in the shapes. Remember to mix your colors carefully!

Draw: Draw a large garden scene for Zara the Zebra. In the center of the page, draw a large circle divided into six equal slices (a color wheel). Color the three primary colors (red, yellow, blue) in every other slice. Mix these to create secondary colors (orange, green, purple) in the remaining slices. Add a small picture of Zara standing next to your color wheel holding a paintbrush.



Label words: Primary · Secondary · Red · Yellow · Blue · Green · Orange · Purple

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw three circles in a triangle shape. Color the top circle red, the bottom-left circle yellow, and the bottom-right circle blue. What do we call these three colors? (Write your answer below)
2. Step 2: Between the red and yellow circles, draw a shape. Color it orange. How did you make this color? (Example: I mixed red and yellow.)
3. Step 3: Between the yellow and blue circles, draw a shape. Color it green. What two colors did you mix to make green?

4. Step 4: Between the blue and red circles, draw a shape. Color it purple. What two colors did you mix to make purple?
