Learning objective: To identify and understand primary, secondary, and warm/cool colors in art.

Read the front of each card. Try to guess the answer before you look at the back. Use the word bank if you get stuck!

What are the three Primary colors?	What happens when you mix two primary colors?
Red, yellow and blue.	You make a secondary color.
Which color do you get if you mix red and yellow?	Which color do you get if you mix blue and yellow?
Orange.	Green.
Which color do you get if you mix red and blue?	Name one 'Warm' color that reminds you of the sun.
Purple.	Red, orange, or yellow.
Name one 'Cool' color that reminds you of water.	Are primary colors made by mixing other colors?
Blue, green, or purple.	No, they are base colors.
What do we call a color wheel?	Zara is painting a sunset. Should she use warm or cool colors?
A tool that shows how colors relate to each other.	Warm colors.
Zara is painting the ocean. Should she use warm or cool colors?	Which primary color is in both green and purple?
Cool colors.	Blue.
