

Zara's Colorful World: A Guide to Color Theory

Explore the rainbow with Zara the Zebra and master the art of color!

- The three primary colors are red, yellow, and blue. You cannot make these colors by mixing others together.
- Secondary colors are made by mixing two primary colors. For example, red plus yellow makes orange.
- Blue plus yellow mixed together makes the color green.
- Red plus blue mixed together makes the color purple.
- A color wheel shows how colors relate to each other in a circle.

Did you know? Did you know? If you mix all the colors of light together, you get white light! But when you mix paints together, the more colors you add, the darker the mixture becomes.
