2. 2. True or False: You cannot make primary colors by mixing other colors. (1 mark)

3. 3. True or False: Mixing two primary colors creates a secondary color. (1 mark)

4. 4. What color do you get when you mix Blue and Yellow? (Hint: Think of grass!) (1 mark)

5. 5. Which color is made by mixing Red and Yellow? [A] Blue [B] Green [C] Orange* [D] Black. (1 mark)

6. 6. True or False: Mixing Red and Blue makes Yellow. (1 mark)

7. 7. Is Red a Primary or Secondary color? (1 mark)

8. 8. What color do you get if you mix Red and Blue? (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: An artist uses a color wheel to help choose colors that look good together. (1 mark)

10. 10. Is Green a Primary or Secondary color? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a small color wheel. Use a red circle, a yellow circle, and a blue circle. In the gaps between them, draw the new colors you created by mixing them!
