

Zara the Zebra's Colorful Art Adventure

Learning objective: To understand the color wheel, including primary and secondary colors.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the colors. Follow the steps to show what you know about mixing colors.

Word bank: Primary · Secondary · Red · Yellow · Blue · Green · Orange · Purple

1. Zara the Zebra wants to paint a picture. Name the three primary colors that she needs to start with. (3 marks)

2. If you mix Red and Yellow together, which color do you make? Start your sentence like this: When I mix Red and Yellow, I make... (1 mark)

3. Which color is made by mixing Blue and Yellow? Start your sentence like this: When I mix Blue and Yellow, I make... (1 mark)

4. Which color is made by mixing Blue and Red? Start your sentence like this: When I mix Blue and Red, I make... (1 mark)

5. Are Green, Orange, and Purple called primary or secondary colors? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a simple circle divided into six parts. Color the sections using the primary colors (Red, Yellow, Blue) and the secondary colors (Green, Orange, Purple) in the correct order around the circle.



Extension challenge: Zara wants to paint a sunset. Which colors would you choose to make it look warm? Write down two colors and explain why.
