

Zara's Color Explorer Diary

Learning objective: To identify primary colors and explore how they mix to create secondary colors through creative observation.

Help Zara the zebra find colors in the world around you! Use this diary to record your discoveries. Find objects that match the primary colors and then experiment with mixing paint to see what new colors you can create. Remember to use your best handwriting or ask a grown-up to help you scribe your observations.

Word bank: primary · mix · secondary · bright · shade · red · yellow · blue · green · purple · orange

1. My Primary Discovery: Find something red, yellow, or blue in your classroom or home. What did you find?

2. Mixing Magic: If you mix red and yellow paint together, what color do you make? Describe it.

3. Blue and Yellow: What happens when you mix blue and yellow paint? Tell me what you see.

4. My Favorite Color: Which color makes you feel the happiest? Why do you like this color?

5. Zara's Pattern Challenge: Can you spot a pattern today? Describe the colors you see in the pattern.

Extension challenge: Can you go on a color hunt outside and find a natural object for every color of the rainbow? Share your findings with a friend!
