

Zara's Springtime Easter Garden

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills and explore patterns, shapes, and seasonal themes through creative drawing.

Help Zara the zebra decorate her beautiful garden for Easter! Follow the steps below to create your very own scene, then use the word bank to label your picture.

Draw: Create a bright and colorful Easter garden scene. Include a large yellow sun in the sky, patches of green grass at the bottom, and three ovals to represent eggs. Encourage the use of different colors and patterns (like stripes or spots) on the eggs, reflecting Zara the zebra's love for art. Add a small basket shape near the eggs.



Label words: egg · flower · grass · sun · basket

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big, bright sun in the corner of your paper.
2. Step 2: Draw some tall, wavy grass at the bottom of your paper.
3. Step 3: Draw three oval-shaped Easter eggs hiding in the grass.
4. Step 4: Draw a basket next to the grass to carry the eggs in.
5. Step 5: Label your picture using the words from the word bank.
