

Zara's Big and Small Art Adventure

Learning objective: To understand the concept of perspective by observing how objects appear smaller when they are further away.

Look at the picture and notice how Zara the Zebra is drawing. Color the objects that are close to Zara with bright, bold colors. Color the objects that are far away with lighter, softer colors to show they are in the distance.

Colour this: A scenic landscape featuring Zara the Zebra standing on the left side of the foreground.
