

Zara's Sculpture Studio: My Art Plan

Learning objective: To explore 3D form and plan a sculpture using natural or recycled materials, supporting creative development and fine motor skills.

Help Zara the zebra plan her next art project! Look around the classroom or garden for interesting materials. Think about how to join your pieces together to build something that can stand up on its own. Use this sheet to describe your sculpture and draw your ideas before you start building.

1. My Sculpture Name: Give your art piece a special name.

2. Materials I Need: What will you use to build it? (e.g., sticks, clay, boxes, or stones).

3. The Shape: What shapes can you see in your sculpture? (e.g., a tall tower, a round ball, or a apartment base).

4. Joining Together: How will you stick your pieces together? (e.g., tape, glue, string, or balancing them carefully).

5. My Favorite Part: Why do you like your sculpture design?

Extension challenge: Once you have finished your sculpture, take a photograph of it or stand it in a 'gallery' area of the classroom. Can you describe how it feels to touch? Is it rough, smooth, bumpy, or soft?
