

Max's Math Store: Conjunction Challenge

Learning objective: To use conjunctions to join two simple sentences together.

Max the monkey is running a store. He needs to join his notes together to make them clearer. Use the conjunctions in the word bank to join the two short sentences into one long sentence. Write your new sentence on the lines provided.

Word bank: and · but · because · so · or

1. Max sold a red pencil. He sold a blue eraser. (Use 'and') (2 marks)

2. The store is busy. Max is very happy. (Use 'so') (2 marks)

3. Max wanted to sell a toy plane. He had no stock left. (Use 'but') (2 marks)

4. Max opened the store early. He wanted to finish his work. (Use 'because') (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey standing in his store with a shelf full of fun school items like notebooks, pens, and rulers.



Extension challenge: Can you write one more sentence about Max the shopkeeper using the conjunction 'or'?
