Learning objective: To use descriptive language to build a character for a story.

Hello! I am Pip the bookworm. Today, we are going to create a brand new character for your own story. Use the boxes below to help you describe who they are. Use the word bank to help you find the best words. Remember to use full sentences and capital letters.

Word bank: brave · kind · cheerful · curious · bright · tall · small · friendly · shiny · adventurous · polite · helpful

1. Character Name and Appearance: Who is your character? What do they look like? (e.g. color of eyes, clothes, or fur) (2 marks)

2. Personality: What are they like? Are they shy, funny, or very busy? Use at least two describing words. (2 marks)

3. Favorite Thing: What is one thing your character loves to do? Where do they like to go? (2 marks)

4. A Special Skill: What is your character really good at? Can they run fast, jump high, or tell great jokes? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write one sentence about where your character lives? Does it have a garden or a tall tower?
