

Diwali: The Festival of Light

Learning objective: To understand the key themes and traditions of Diwali, the Hindu festival of light.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Max the monkey is here to help you solve these puzzles!

Diwali is a special festival celebrated by many people. It is known as the Festival of Light. The story tells of Rama and Sita coming home after a long time away. People light small clay lamps called diyas to show the way. They also make colorful patterns on the floor called rangoli. The festival celebrates light winning over dark, and good winning over evil.
