

Grade 3 Grammar Flashcards with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and understand key Grade 3 grammar terms including nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and fronted adverbials.

Max the Monkey needs your help to sort his grammar puzzles! Read the front of the card. Think about the answer. Then, turn it over to check if you are right. Use the word bank if you get stuck.

What is a Noun?

A noun is a word that names a person, place, or thing.

What is a Verb?

A verb is a word that describes an action or a state of being.

What is an Adjective?

An adjective is a word that describes a noun.

What is an Adverb?

An adverb describes how an action happens (often ending in -ly).

What is a Pronoun?

A pronoun replaces a noun, such as he, she, it, or they.

What is a Fronted Adverbial?

A word or phrase at the start of a sentence that describes when, where, or how.

What is a Determiner?

A word that introduces a noun, such as 'the', 'a', or 'my'.

What is a Conjunction?

A word that joins two sentences or clauses, like 'and', 'but', or 'because'.

What is a Preposition?

A word that shows the position of something, such as 'under', 'on', or 'behind'.

What is a Collective Noun?

A word used to name a group of people, animals, or things, like 'flock' or 'team'.
