

Max's Busy Bakery: Sequencing Instructions

Learning objective: To understand how to sequence instructions using time-connectives and imperative verbs.

Max the monkey is baking a yummy treat, but his recipe cards have got mixed up! Look at the five steps below. Put them in the correct order by writing numbers 1 to 5 in the boxes. Use the word bank to help you understand the order words.

Word bank: First · Then · Next · After that · Finally · Mix · Pour · Bake

1. ☐ Pour the milk into the bowl. (1 mark)

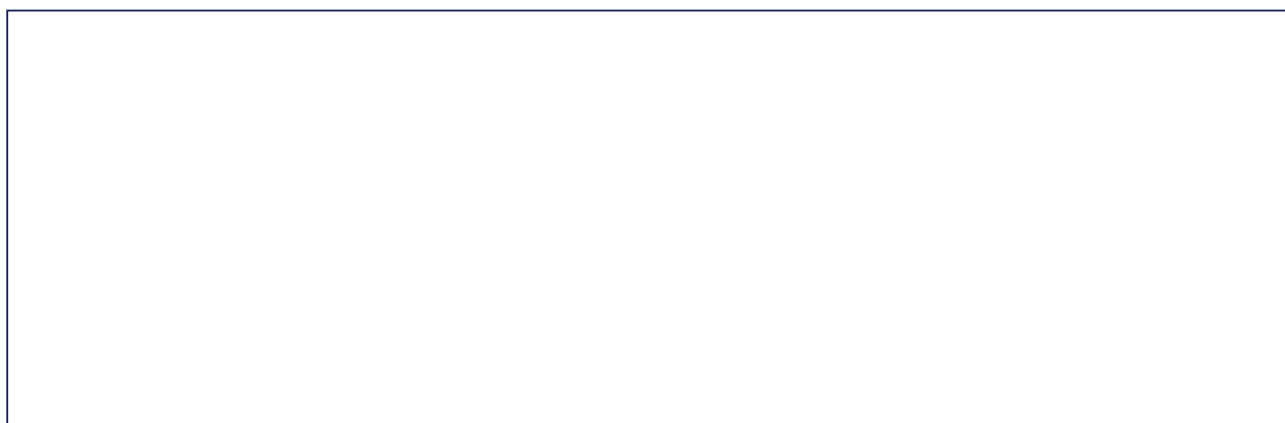
2. ☐ Finally, decorate your cake with fruit. (1 mark)

3. ☐ First, wash your hands carefully. (1 mark)

4. ☐ Next, mix the flour and eggs together. (1 mark)

5. ☐ Then, bake the cake in the hot oven. (1 mark)
