

Max and Pip's Noun and Verb Flashcards

Learning objective: To identify and understand the difference between nouns (people, places, things) and verbs (doing or being words).

Look at the front of each card. Read the word or sentence. Decide if it is a noun or a verb. Check the answer on the back of the card. Use the word bank if you need help.

What is a noun?

A noun is a naming word for a person, place, or thing.

What is a verb?

A verb is an action word or a doing word.

Is the word 'Max' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a name of a person).

Is the word 'jump' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is the word 'caterpillar' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a thing/animal).

Is the word 'read' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is the word 'park' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a place).

Is the word 'smile' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is the word 'book' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a thing).

Is the word 'run' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is the word 'pencil' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a thing).

Is the word 'eat' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).
