- A noun is a naming word. It can be a person (like Max), a place (like a park), or a thing (like a book).
- A verb is an action word. It tells us what the noun is doing, like jumping, eating, or reading.
- Max is a noun because he is a person (or monkey!).
- Climbing is a verb because it is an action.
- To make a sentence, put a noun and a verb together: 'Max climbs.'

Did you know? Did you know? Every single sentence you write needs a verb! Without a verb, your words are just a list, but with one, you have an action-packed story to tell.
