

Leo's Poetry Workshop: Create Your Own Poem

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and sensory details to write a poem based on a specific theme.

Today, we are going to write a poem with Leo the Lion. Follow the steps below to build your poem. Think about what you can see, hear, or feel. Use the word bank if you get stuck!

Word bank: shimmering · gentle · whisper · bright · golden · rhythm · breeze · melody · soft · sparkling

1. Choose a subject for your poem (e.g., a forest, the ocean, or the night sky). Write it here: (1 mark)

2. Describe your subject using an adjective. (Example: The [adjective] tree...) (2 marks)

3. What is one sound your subject makes? Use a verb to describe it. (2 marks)

4. Write two lines that rhyme to finish your poem: (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add a 'simile' to your poem? Try to compare your subject to something else using the word 'like' or 'as'.
