

Max's Math Store Punctuation

Learning objective: To use full stops, capital letters, and question marks correctly in sentences.

Max the monkey is opening a store. Read the sentences below. Some are missing capital letters, full stops, or question marks. Use your pencil to fix them. Look at the word bank for help.

max is opening a new store. he sells red apples and blue pens. do you want to visit his store. the store is open on monday.

1. 1. Find the sentence that asks something. What mark should go at the end of it? (2 marks)

2. 2. Max starts with a capital letter. Why does his name need one? (2 marks)

3. 3. Rewrite the first sentence correctly: 'max is opening a new store.' (2 marks)

4. 4. How many full stops do you need for the whole passage? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey standing in his store. Show him holding a red apple and a blue pen.



Extension challenge: Write one new sentence about what else Max might sell in his store. Remember to start with a capital letter and end with a full stop!
