

Max the Monkey's Spelling Adventure

Learning objective: To practice spelling words with the 'sure' suffix and identifying common homophones.

Read the story below. Look for the words in bold. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Follow the sentence starters.

Max the monkey loves to solve puzzles. He found a map to some hidden **treasure**. 'It is a **pleasure** to find new paths,' Max said. He used a ruler to **measure** the distance on the map. 'Look over **there**!' he shouted to his friends. 'I think **their** map is missing a corner, but **they're** ready to help me look.'
