

Pip's Word Collector: My Favorite Words

Learning objective: To identify and use interesting vocabulary to describe feelings, objects, and actions.

Pip the caterpillar loves collecting new words! Use this sheet to find exciting words to replace 'boring' ones. Read the prompts and write your own descriptive sentences.

Word bank: enormous · tiny · shimmering · dull · joyful · gloomy · sprinted · trudged · magnificent · baffling

1. Pip has found a boring word: 'big'. Write a new, exciting word to describe something large, and write a sentence using it. (2 marks)

2. Think of a word to describe how you feel when you learn something new. Write your word and tell me why you chose it. (2 marks)

3. Max the monkey is moving quickly. Instead of 'ran', what exciting action word could you use? Write it in a sentence. (2 marks)

4. Find a word from the word bank that describes something bright and shiny. Write a sentence about a 'shimmering' object. (2 marks)
