

My Favorite Book Adventure: A World Book Day Writing Frame

Learning objective: To write a short, structured review of a favorite book using descriptive language.

Use this frame to write about a book you love. Read the questions and use the sentence starters to help you write your sentences. Look at the word bank if you need help choosing a word.

1. Introduction: What is the title of your favorite book and who is the main character? Start your sentence with: My favorite book is called... (2 marks)

2. The Plot: What happens in the story? Start your sentence with: In this story, the main character... (2 marks)

3. Why I like it: What is the best part of the book? Start your sentence with: I like this book because... (2 marks)

4. Conclusion: Would you tell a friend to read it? Start your sentence with: I would tell a friend to read this book because... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you use one adjective to describe how the main character feels at the end of the story?
