1. 1. Finn sees a mountain. Is a mountain a physical feature or a human feature? (2 marks)

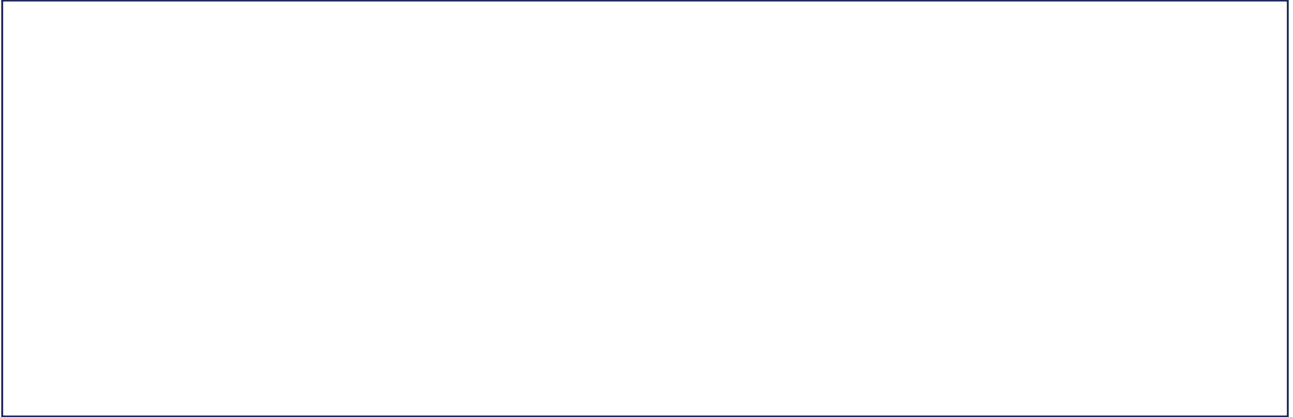
2. 2. Name one human feature that people might build in a town. (2 marks)

5. 5. Look at your local area. Describe one physical feature and one human feature you can see near your school. Write a short paragraph. (5 marks)
