

Exploring Our World with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify and describe the differences between physical and human features of our landscape.

Finn the Dolphin needs your help! Look at the list of features below. Decide if they are natural (physical) or made by humans. Use the word bank to help you.

Word bank: Physical · Human · Mountain · Bridge · River · Road · Forest · Building

1. A physical feature is something natural. Name two physical features you might see in the wild. (2 marks)

2. A human feature is something built by people. Name two human features you might see in your town. (2 marks)

3. Is a mountain a physical feature or a human feature? Circle your answer: Physical / Human (1 mark)

4. Is a road a physical feature or a human feature? Circle your answer: Physical / Human (1 mark)

5. Complete this sentence: A forest is a _____ feature because it grows in nature. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a park. Include at least one physical feature (like a tree or a pond) and one human feature (like a bench or a path).



Extension challenge: Imagine you are building a new town. List one physical feature you would want to have nearby and one human feature you would build for the people living there.
