

Exploring the Polar Regions with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify and describe the features of the Arctic and the Antarctic.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell your answers. Finn the Dolphin is here to help!

Finn the Dolphin has swum all the way to the top and bottom of the world. He wants to see if you can remember what he found there!

Word bank: Arctic · Antarctic · Ice · Cold · North Pole · South Pole · Penguins · Polar bears

1. Finn is at the top of the world. What is the name of this region? (1 mark)

2. Finn is now at the bottom of the world. What is the name of this region? (1 mark)

3. Write down two things that describe the weather in the Polar Regions. (2 marks)

4. Which animal lives in the Arctic? (Hint: They have thick white fur!) (1 mark)

5. Which animal lives in the Antarctic? (Hint: They love to waddle on the ice!) (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of the Arctic. Make sure to include lots of ice and a polar bear.



Extension challenge: If you could visit a Polar Region, what one item of warm clothing would you pack in your bag? Write a full sentence to explain why.
