

Finn's Green Ocean Project

Learning objective: To identify ways to live sustainably and protect our environment.

Follow the steps below to draw a sustainable town by the sea. Use your pencil to sketch, then add color. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a bright, colorful scene of a coastal town. Include a house with solar panels on the roof, a bicycle on the path, a recycling bin outside, and a wind turbine on a hill in the background. Keep the style simple and clear so labels can be added easily.



Label words: solar panels · recycling bin · bicycle · trees · wind turbine

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a house. On the roof, draw squares for solar panels. These catch sunlight to make clean electricity. Label them.
2. Step 2: Draw a bicycle next to the house. Why is a bicycle better for the air than a car? Write one sentence.
3. Step 3: Draw a large recycling bin near the front door. Label the bin.
4. Step 4: Draw a wind turbine in the distance. Wind turbines turn the wind into energy. Label it.
