*Word bank: Magma · Lava · Crater · Vent · Ash*

**1. Finn is looking at the top of a volcano. What is the name of the bowl-shaped opening at the top? (1 mark)**

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**2. Hot liquid rock is found deep underground. What do we call this when it is inside the Earth? (1 mark)**

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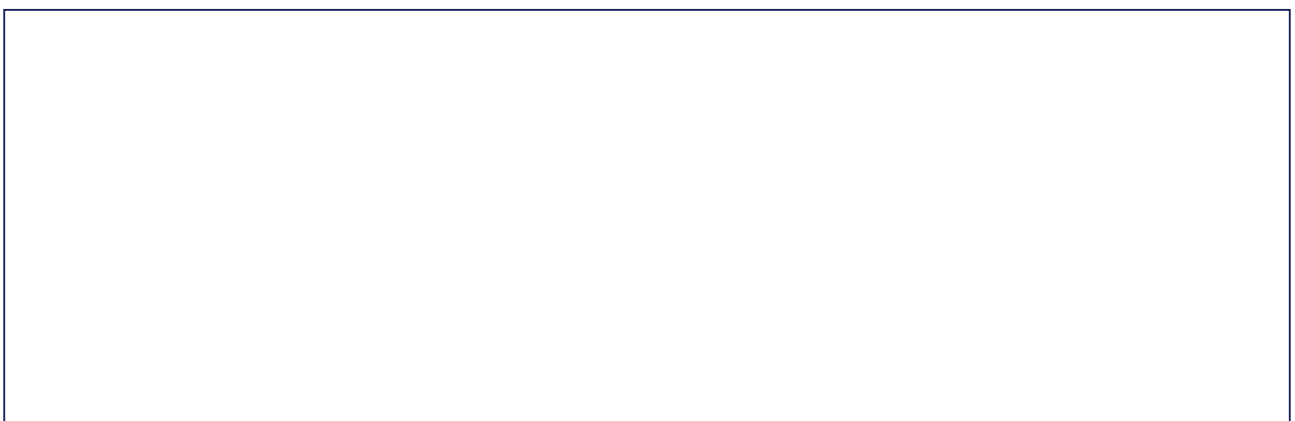
**3. When the hot rock reaches the surface of the Earth, it changes its name. What is it called now? (1 mark)**

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**4. Name one thing that a volcano might throw into the air during an eruption. (1 mark)**
