

Heroes of Fairness: A History Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To understand that people have worked together throughout history to make the world a fairer place for everyone.

Follow the steps below to create a picture about fairness. Use the word bank to add labels to your drawing. Remember to think about how your characters are working together.

Draw: Draw a scene featuring two friendly characters (you can draw people or use Ellie the elephant and Leo the lion) standing together in a park. They should be holding a colorful sign that says 'Fairness'. The style should be clear and cheerful. Include a bright sun in the corner and ensure the characters are smiling to show they are working as a team.



Label words: fairness · protest · sign · community · change · together

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw two people standing together holding a sign that says 'Fairness for All'.
2. Step 2: Draw a sun above them to show a bright future. Label your drawing using one word from the word bank.
3. Step 3: Why is it important to treat everyone fairly? (Sentence starter: It is important to be fair because...)
4. Step 4: Draw a small badge on one of the characters' shirts showing a symbol of peace or a heart.
