

Max the Monkey's Angle Adventure!

Max says: Look for the corners! Spot the angles all around us!

- An acute angle is small and sharp. It is smaller than a right angle.
- A right angle is like the corner of a book. It is exactly 90 degrees.
- An obtuse angle is wide. It is bigger than a right angle but smaller than a straight line.
- We measure angles in degrees (°).
- Max uses his arms to show different angles. A small gap is acute, a square shape is a right angle, and a big wide stretch is obtuse!

Did you know? Did you know? A right angle is exactly 90 degrees. It looks like the perfect corner of a square or a piece of paper. If you spin around in a full circle, you have turned 360 degrees!
