

Max the Monkey's Easter Math Fun

Learning objective: To practice addition, subtraction, and money skills using an Easter theme for Kindergarten pupils.

Read each card carefully. Max the Monkey has hidden math puzzles inside these Easter eggs! Work out the answers to help Max fill his basket.

Max has 5 chocolate eggs and finds 3 more. How many eggs does he have altogether?	An Easter card costs 20p and a sticker costs 5p. How much do they cost in total?
8 eggs	25p
There are 10 bunnies in the garden. 4 hop away. How many bunnies are left?	If you have 10p and spend 7p on a chocolate treat, how much change do you have?
6 bunnies	3p
Zara the Zebra paints 6 blue eggs and 4 yellow eggs. How many eggs did she paint in total?	A basket costs £4. If you have £6, how much money is left if you buy the basket?
10 eggs	£2
Pip the caterpillar finds 9 jelly beans and eats 2. How many jelly beans are left?	What is the total of 12p and 8p?
7 jelly beans	20p
Max has 15p. He buys an egg for 10p. How much does he have left?	If 3 birds are sitting on an Easter branch and 3 more join them, how many are there in total?
5p	6 birds
You have 11p and find 4p. How much money do you have now?	There are 20 eggs in a box. You take away 10. How many remain?
15p	10 eggs
